COPPINI ASPIRING ARTIST SCHOLARSHIP

The Coppini Academy of Fine Arts hosts its annual scholarship award in April of each year. \$3000 will be awarded to a Texas high school student with plans to continue their art education at an accredited institution of higher learning.

Eligibility

Any Texas high school senior with planned enrollment in accredited institution of higher learning with fine art as the major

Application requirements

1. A signed, completed application along with a written statement detailing your future plans in classic, representational art and a written explanation of one of the works you submit at the interview.
2. Letter of recommendation from high school art instructor
3. Portfolio – submitted at the interview - minimum 10 works - maximum 20 works
 - One third of the portfolio work must be from direct observation (life not photo)
 - All of the portfolio work must be classic, representational art (not abstract, surreal, etc.)
 - All portfolio work must be presentable (not soiled, wrinkled, torn, etc.)
 - One portfolio work must have been completed outside of classroom environment
4. Interview with professional artists and CAFA staff concerning attitudes about art, future art goals and describing the submitted works.
